We are pleased to announce the forthcoming 57th Zakopane Conference on Nuclear Physics entitled "Extremes of the Nuclear Landscape" which will take place in Zakopane, Poland during the week of August 25th – September 1st, 2024. The conference is organized by the Henryk Niewodniczański Institute of Nuclear Physics of the Polish Academy of Sciences (IFJ PAN), Kraków.

Most of the Conference time will be devoted to reviews and reports on the latest achievements in nuclear research. The scientific program of the Conference will consist in part of a series of topical sessions focused on:

- High spin states
- Nuclear astrophysics
- Nuclear fission
