

## Sightseeing & Social program

## Monday, 6 July 2015, 19:00

After the opening part of the conference, including an opening lecture and a visit to the Cyclotron Centre Bronowice, both of them taking place on the premises of the Institute of Nuclear Physics, you are invited to the **Welcome Party** in the garden of the Crown Piast Hotel. Barbecue, salads and drinks will be served.

## Wednesday, 8 July 2015, 14:30

The best part of Wednesday afternoon is devoted to a **sightseeing tour** of Kraków. After lunch, at 14:30, we will be driven to the spot close to the city centre. The first point of the programme is a visit to the **Collegium Maius**, which is the oldest college of the Jagiellonian University founded in 1364. The **University Museum** in the Collegium Maius shows splendid historic rooms with original furnishings, a fine collection of the old European art and unique science instruments. After visiting the museum, we will take a ca. 2h tour. At the **Main Market Square** – the biggest medieval square in Europe, we will see the **Town Hall Tower**, **St. Mary's church**, famous for its magnificent wooden altarpiece, and the Sukiennice building – **Cloth Hall** – where textile trade used to take place. Strolling down old streets we will reach the **Wawel hill** with the **Royal Castle** and **Cathedral**, and then, via the Planty gardens we will reach the restaurant on the Grodzka street to have dinner.

## Thursday, 9 July 2015, 20:00

The Multis 2015 conference closing dinner will be held in the restaurant of the Crown Piast Hotel. During the meeting the prizes for the best poster and oral contribution by young participants will be awarded and, most probably, plans for a follow-up meeting will be announced.
